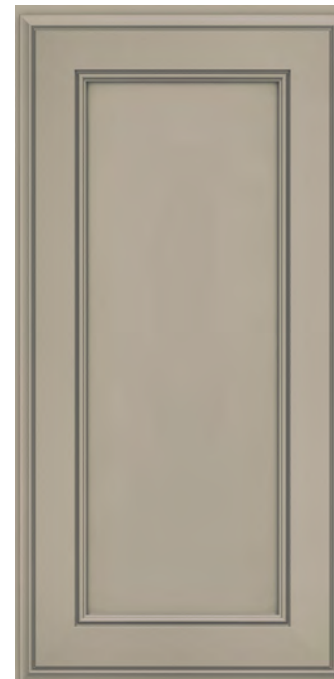
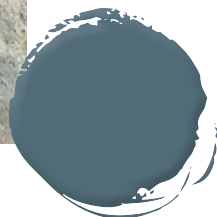
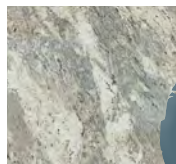
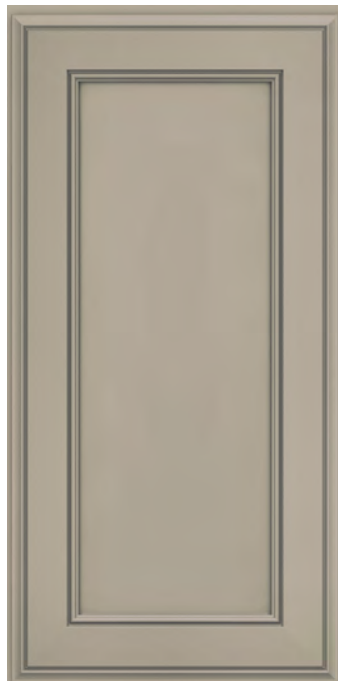
For a pleasant contrast, balance the warmth of Overcast with the lighter tone of Canvas. Blue walls with grey undertones introduce a bold mood.

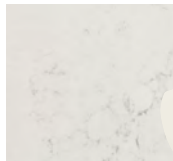
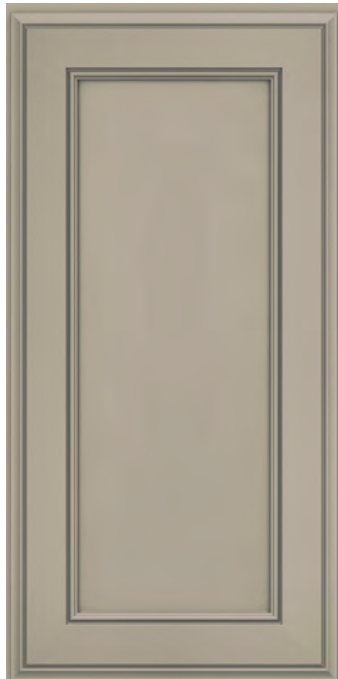

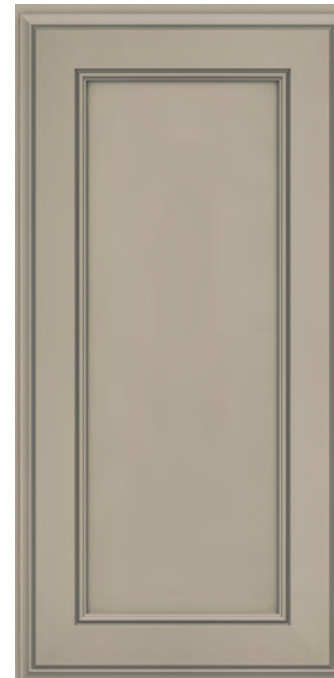
